



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

PRINCESS OF NARADHIWAS UNIVERSITY

AND

JENDERAL SOEDIRMAN UNIVERSITY

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on this day: Monday July 31st, 2017

BETWEEN

PRINCESS OF NARDHIWAS UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as “PNU”), a public institution of higher learning established under the National Educational, whose address is 99 Moo 8, Kokkean Subdistrict, Muang District, Narathiwat, 96000

AND

JENDERAL SOEDIRMAN UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as “UNSOED”, a public university located in JL.HR Boenyamin 708 Grendeng, Purwokerto Utara, Banyumas, Central Java, Indonesia

(PNU and UNSOED hereinafter referred to singularly as “the Party” and collective as “the Parties”)

HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:

1. OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this MOU and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time in force in each Party’s country, will endeavor to strengthen, promote and develop co-operation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

2. AREA OF CO-OPERATION

2.1 Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:

- a. Collaboration in conducting course of study and training at the undergraduate and graduate levels;
- b. Collaboration in research projects;
- c. The exchange of students, practicum, internship program and cooperative education;
- d. The exchange of academic information and materials

2.2 For the purpose of implementing the co- operation in respect of any area in sub-clause the Parties may enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The financial expense of the collaboration in detail will be explained in the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) of each co-operation area.

4. EFFECT OF MOU

This MOU serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be demanded to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

5. ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

5.1 This MOU will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years.

5.2 This MOU may be extended for a further periods as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.
